



## Fondant Cutter Assembly Instructions

\*\*\*Please read **completely** before building your fondant cutter!\*\*\*

First form what will be your handles by screwing two 1.5” **threaded** spacers together with a 1” threaded rod. Do the same for the remaining two.

Take your 7” threaded rod and screw it in to a 1.5” threaded spacer. Slide on your first fondant cutter disc.

Depending on what size ribbon you will be cutting will determine which size spacer you will slide on next. There are many combinations of sizes. Remember you don’t have to fit all 5 fondant cutter discs on if you plan on doing large ribbons, sometimes only 2 or 3 will fit depending on the width. If you choose to do very small ribbons, using the smallest available spacer then fill in the remaining space (after all your discs are on the rod) with your remaining spacers. You can also vary ribbon sizes on one fondant cutter.

Slide on your selected size spacer, then fondant cutter disc, then spacer, then fondant cutter disc and so on.

When you get to the end of the 7” threaded rod, screw on the other handle you formed earlier and hand tighten.

Now you’re ready to roll! Happy Baking!
